Hands should be cleaned immediately before direct patient contact and immediately after. This can be done with soap and water or alcohol gel using the following technique.

Palm to Palm



2
Right palm over back of left hand.
Left palm over back of right hand



3
Palm to palm fingers
interlaced



4
Backs of fingers to opposing palms
with fingers interlaced.



5
Rotational rubbing of right thumb
clasped over left palm and left palm
over right palm




6
Rotational rubbing backwards and
forwards with clasped fingers of right
hand in palm of left and vice versa

Washing should take 15 -30 seconds. Rinse and dry hands thoroughly.

We'll hear from other speakers as well, including **University of Louisville President Dr. Neeli Bendapudi**.


The afternoon will feature a facilitated community discussion on **Creating the Future in Your Space Through a Culture of Sustainability**.

The MudSlinger Hero from the East

Gliding through a library audiobook of a brief history of eastern Europe the other day, I ran into a monster that I think we all can appreciate. No, not Dracula--although he's a monster of some stature from the east of that continent; true. It was Golem, a mud monster called from the deep by a Medieval rabbi whenever yiddish folks were targeted unfairly, as was so often the case back then (accused of hacking children into pieces and such). If you haven't been exposed to Golem, it's high time you were. Probably many common folk are feeling pushed around by forces that don't care about us--and wrongly accuse and bully us--because of pride of place and heritage. The idea of a collective-unconsciousness-based phantasmic humunculus (that does the marauding for us to keep the haughty from being too hubric) is a satisfying one. While I doubt a real Golem will land on the shores of our Ohio River, I'm convinced Portland (with lots of access to water with silt build-up--thanks to our very own lock-and-dam) would be the first place in Louisville for such an oozy and lugubrious landing. Indeed, I posit that a gargantuan Golem would be concocted due to our overabundance of mud, mud, mud...especially since the riverfront forest has been lain waste this last fortnight from 15th on down--and all that remains is mud and homeless encampment residue (and a few lucky remnant sycamores).
